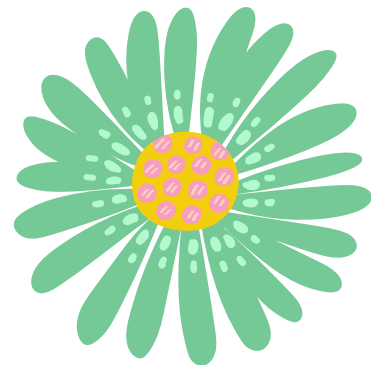
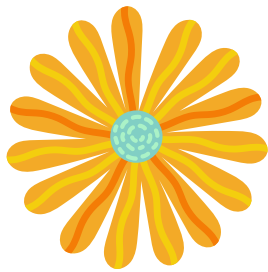
WORLD HERITAGE DAY CELEBRATION – EXOTIC INDIA

FIELD TRIP TO DUMAS URBAN HEALTH CENTRE

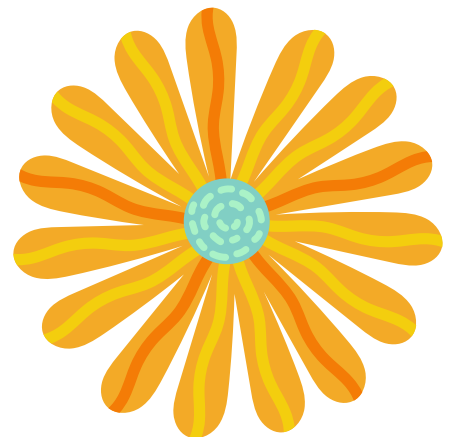

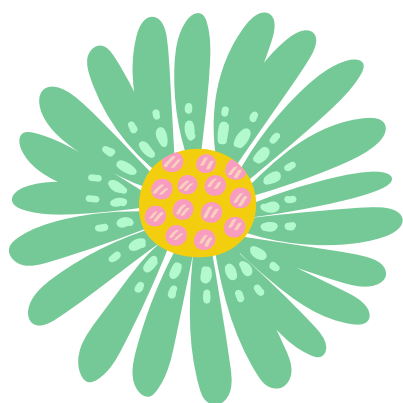
"My One-In-A-Million Mom" - A Slam Book for Mother

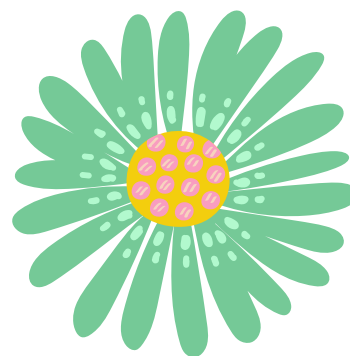
Inter Class Poster Making Competition

भारतीय संस्कृति का बदलता रूप.

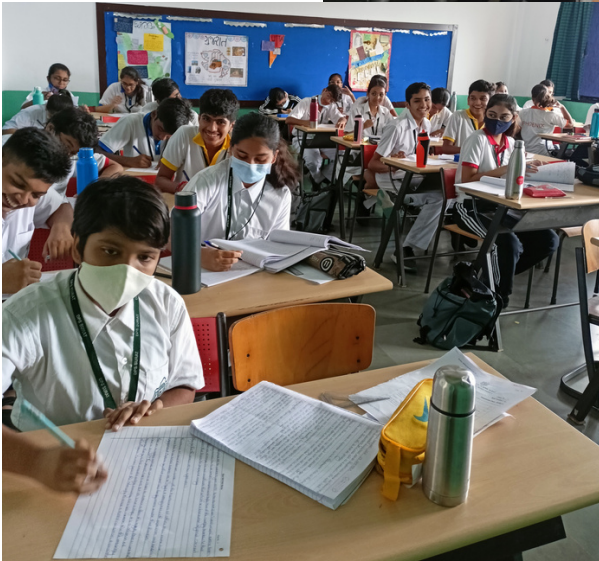
The harness came up for these participants with a word limit of 250 - 300 words.

Special Assembly: Independence Day

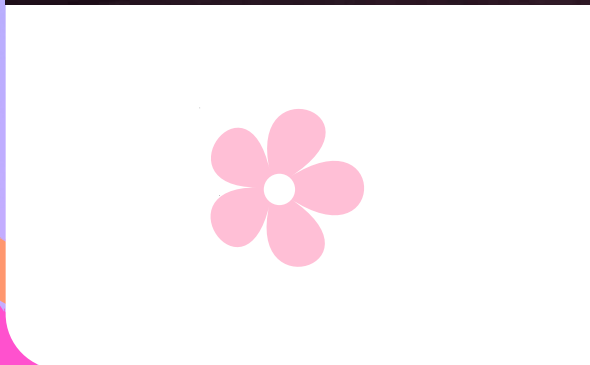
The Freedom Saga

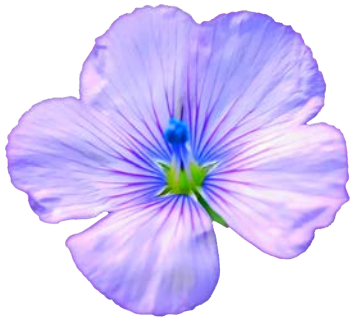
KALAMAHAKUMBH BAND
