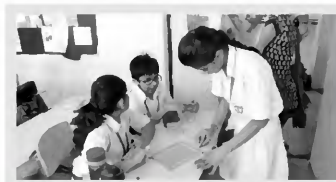
**THE SACRED COW**

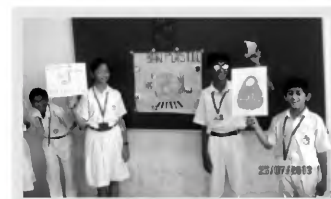
■ **NATIONAL INTER-DPS BOYS CHESS CHAMPIONSHIP 2013**

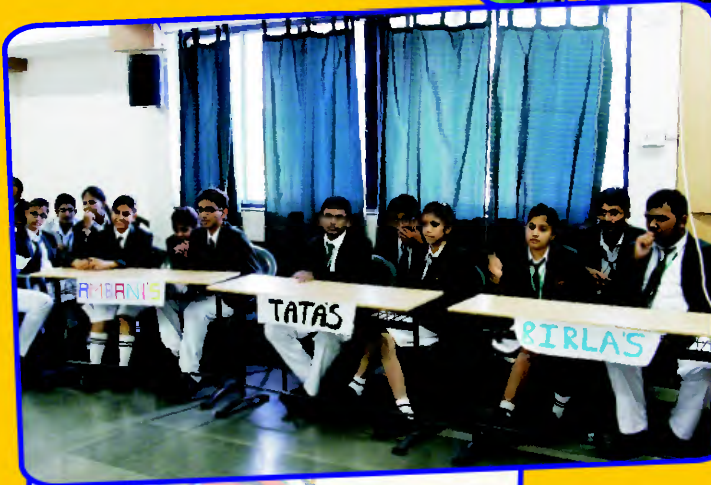


**HINDI DIVAS**

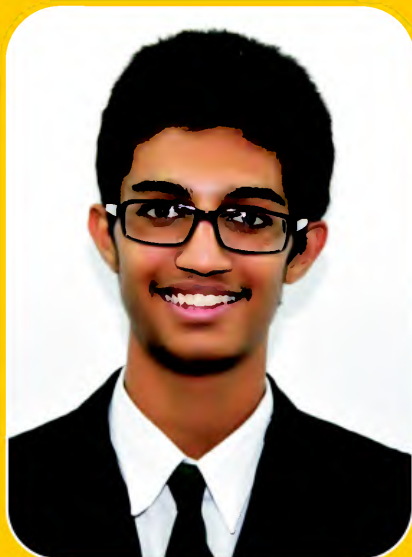
