


Our Indian Heritage

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

DPS on 21 October.





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








The children of classes III A to D charioted everyone into our kaleidoscopic past, showing them the history of our evolution and progress on 22 October.




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Special Assembly To

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From14th October 2008 to 17th October 2008 students of classes I & II visited the post office and saw the working of various departments. They also posted Diwali cards to their parents.














The competitive spirit of the students reached its zenith with the Rangoli Making Competition which was held on 18 October. The judges had a tough time judging the beautifully and intricately
