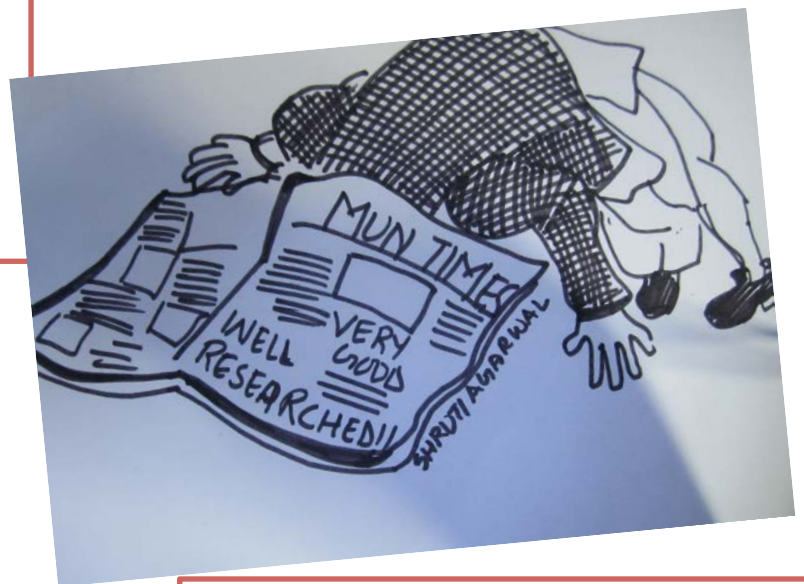

Chair, we know that you aren't very satisfied with the performance of your committee but we are sure that trying to doze off is not a solution to it.

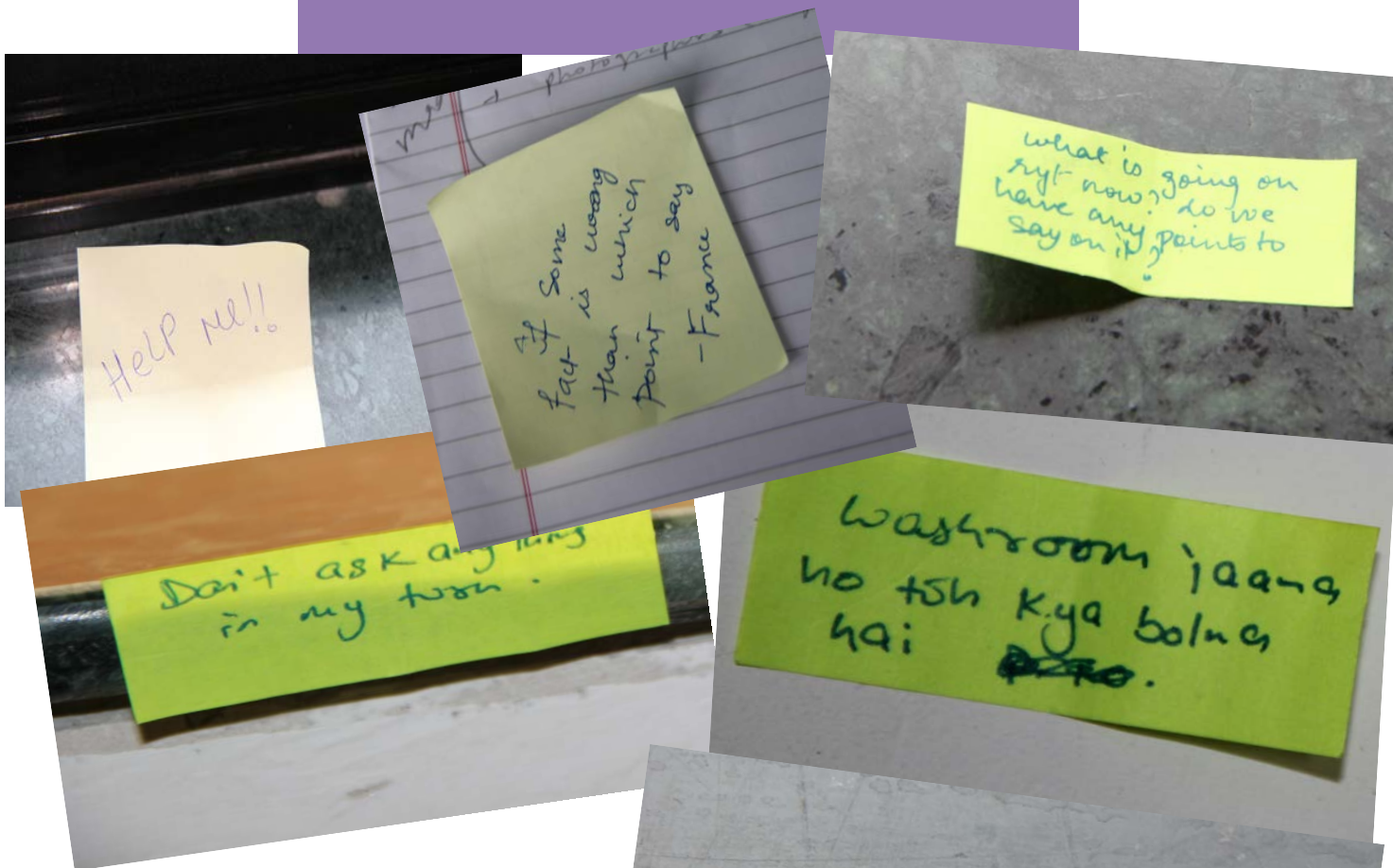
We know that Indians love themselves but the delegate of India must get over with "I, me and myself" and concentrate on other important issues.



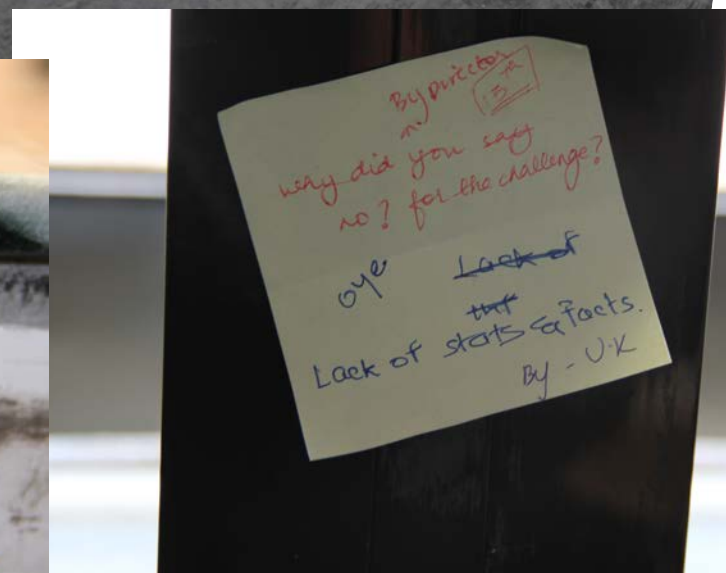
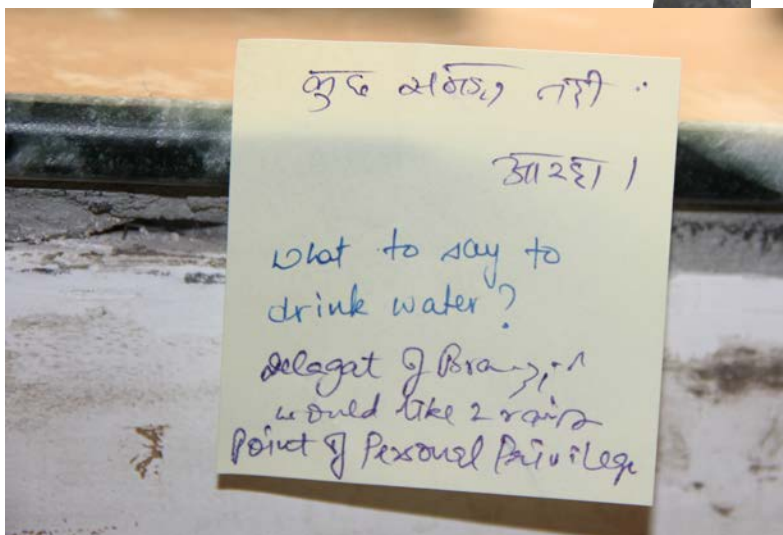
