INFRASTRUCTURE



Protos - The Pre Primary School

Our tiniest learners occupy this section of school. In an ideal world, children ought to spend these years under the fond guidance of grandparents and parents, for the first mores of socialization are best learnt under family guidance.

However, reality dictates otherwise, with children barely three years old or less, being rushed off to school, where they are force fed the alphabet, writing and computing skills, all in a foreign language. All this in aid of gaining admission to a reputed school!

It is to save at least some children from this aberration in nature, that DPS Surat opened its Pre Primary Wing. Admission here is based on child friendly observation measures free of tests and interviews. Learners in our Pre Primary Wing meet smiling, bi-lingual teachers, who are interested in every aspect of their lives, in and outside school, creating a seamless interface between the warm, friendly home and the new and alien school. Thus begins the Learning Partnership between School, Home and Learner.

Children at this age are not expected to read, write and count, though parents do wish for these skills and hence we include them in the syllabus. We are more interested in ensuring that children learn how to interact in a group, learn social skills, make new friends and have plenty of chances to imbibe learning while unconscious of any strain.

Thus, school is a microcosm of the outside world, with children gently being inducted into the social, moral, ethical and aesthetic norms that have shaped human civilization to the present day. All academic and co curricular activities are geared to this one real end.

Deuteros - The Primary School

After an enjoyable early socialization stage in our Pre Primary Wing, the learner is now ready to tackle the fundamentals of knowledge. The curiosity aroused about the world outside is channelized into academic learning through plenty of activities. The focus is on acquiring study skills. Through the experiential learning process, students become actively engaged in posing questions, investigating, experimenting, curiously solving problems, assuming responsibility, being creative and consolidating the whole learning process in the form of a project. Unlike the traditional system, this puts the learners in the forefront.

The efforts put in by the young learners of class 3 and 4 are continuously evaluated through a grading system that records their input, output and achievements. Subject concepts comprehension and skills acquired in the process are assessed too. However, learners of class 5 and 6 are also assessed through the examinations conducted at regular intervals, to get them acquainted with the evaluation system as mandated by the CBSE.

Every academic subject is denoted by basic skills required to study it and the weekly timetable is adjusted accordingly. Discouraging the practice of tuition teachers and rote learning, we follow the Learning Partnership framework, wherein parents are expected to provide an appropriate home environment and moral support for the completion of assignments and experiments. This supplements the atmosphere of 'learning by doing' present in school. The feedback shared helps guide the students to confront challenges, solve them and they gain confidence from such learning experiences. Remedial measures are a built feature of our system. We consciously avoid developing any kind of stigma among the students. We believe in an individual's potential and every attempt to improve is encouraged. Children do not think that they are 'brilliant', 'weak' or in any way different from others. Both teachers and learners are involved in the continual striving for perfection. To ensure an all-round development, we include a wide and varied range of co-curricular activities alongside the academic.

We believe, Learning is not confined to books- Learning from Life's experiences stays lifelong.

Tritos - The Secondary School

New faces, new opportunities, new challenges. Transitioning from Primary to Secondary Wing is indeed a big change for Middle school children. For some it may prove nerve-wracking, for others exciting. This transition is made smooth by the system implemented at the Secondary Wing to avoid any undue strain.

Some day, perhaps, there will be no Board Exams, and an end to the 'gate keeping' that wishes to claim higher education as the privilege of a select few. Until that day, we will continue to prepare our students for Board Exams and they will also show the brilliant results achieved by our very first batch of CBSE candidates. But – we refuse to allow this experience to embitter even a single year of their lives as students. 'Testing' is not equivalent to 'learning' and the difference between 'learning' and 'testing' should be evident to all persons involved in both these processes.

We focus on both formative and summative evaluation. To this end we have Periodic tests, Internal Assessments and Term examinations with continual feedback on student performance through reports and parent teacher interaction. Thus we ensure that the students learn continually throughout the year, with remedial inputs wherever required. This is sufficient to prepare your child to face the Term examinations at the end of the academic year. There is no need to stress out children from the beginning with endless tests and mark reports, in the mistaken belief that this will result in learning.

With balanced emphasis on studies as well as other activities, we ensure that every learner participates in the pursuit of a healthy mind in a healthy body. Not all our students are expected to achieve top marks – but they must do their best in every challenge they face, whether academic or co-curricular. Not so much winning as confident participation; not so much competing but continual learning and improvement – these are our fundamental beliefs.

Eschatos The Senior Secondary School

We believe in the inherent potential of every human being to learn and improve – and this belief has enabled us to encourage the development of students who are everywhere marked for their awareness, alertness and open frankness. We believe with Socrates that learning is a lighting of lamps and not the filling of empty vessels. Every learner comes ready, equipped with the blueprint of learning and we merely provide the right environment and companionship that will act as the catalyst to this vital phenomenon.

At this stage, with Board exam under their belt, our students are eager to confront the world and chart out their unique roles in it. They are the architects of our country's future and whether they become engineers, doctors, teachers, researchers, chemists, media persons, actors or politicians, we expect them to forge new pathways in their relevant spheres of action. Not just India, but the world needs people who are uncompromising in their standards of performance, quick in their decision making ability, unfazed by challenges and capable of overcoming temptations. So this is what our school teaches students to aim at: "Do not just secure a distinction or a degree – but carve your own gateway into the future."

Instead, we insist on more serious and permanent survival skills. We do not want our youngsters to 'blend' and 'chill with the gang' but to stand out with leadership abilities in a world lacking in them. So there is a multiple focus on various academic and meta-academic study skills, personality development, as well as excellence in various competitive spheres like sports, public speaking and dramatics. This is where our learners stand on the threshold of independence and adulthood. We implement rigorous schedules of assignments and assessments to ensure that our learners assume responsibility for their future achievements.

The Sports Complex, Arena is a great asset for the school with a facility of many indoor sports like martial arts, swimming pool, gymnasium, yoga, squash, table tennis, darts, aerobics, squash viewing gallery, badminton, gymnastics and judo. Arena has the facility of basketball court, futsal and hand ball ground also. Students are mentored by committed coaches, who use their knowledge and expertise to help young talents realise their potential. There is ample opportunity for the students to discover and develop their athletic and sporting talents to achieve international recognition.


































Audio Visual Room

The school has a fully equipped Audio Visual room to supplement theoretical instruction at the Pre-Primary, Primary, Secondary and Senior Secondary level. Students have access to facts in a more interesting manner through presentations. The teachers are able to disseminate knowledge via documentaries, videos and talks of eminent personalities.









Seminar Hall

Infirmary


CCTV Surveillance Room

In order to ensure safety and security, the school has installed CCTV cameras covering Pre-Primary, Primary, Secondary and Senior Secondary sections including the corridors, classrooms, offices, sports complex, cafeteria, playground, the entrances and exits and in the parking lot to keep an eye on everyone who enters the school. A special CCTV surveillance room is set up at the Senior Secondary Block to monitor the surveillance in the entire school.



Server Room

To enable better teaching and learning as well as broader information access, we have internet access services, school intranet system for quick communication, and we also host several web pages to keep the students, teachers, parents and the general public updated with the various activities of school. In order to satisfy all these IT related needs, we have a well equipped server room under the supervision of experts in IT field.



Library

The Central Library and Pre-Primary library play a key role in arousing curiosity, understanding and inculcating reading habit in students, thereby scaffolding inquiry learning. Both the libraries are an organised collection of information. Well-qualified Librarians are present to help the students in selecting appropriate books.





Computer Lab

There are seven Computer Labs in the school. The Pre-Primary is fully equipped with iMac. The Primary section has three labs fully equipped with one to one computers, working on Windows OS. The students get opportunity to learn, create and explore under proper guidance of teachers. The presence of experienced teachers in the lab makes the learning process effective for the students. The Computer Lab-3 doubles up as the language lab for students of classes 5 and 6- a place to hone the language skills, where communication skills are shaped and nurtured. The Secondary section has two well equipped labs working on Windows OS. Senior Secondary section has one lab working on Windows OS. It caters to the needs of senior secondary students who have taken Computer Science as their elective subject. Technically qualified faculty to navigate and instruct the students with regards to communication and technology are the hallmark of the Computer Lab in the school.









Counselling Room

Special Educator Room

The Special educator's room provides a positive and safe learning environment for the students who require additional support. The special educators use multiple techniques to reinforce students' positive behaviour and strive to bring changes in academic as well as mental health of the students.



Dance Room

There are separate, spacious and well-equipped dance rooms for the Pre-Primary and Primary students which facilitate aesthetic and artistic nurturing of the young learners. Students get opportunity to hone their artistic expression under the guidance of experts and technical equipments are provided to enhance the teaching-learning process.









Instrumental Music Room

The instrumental music rooms at the Pre-primary and Primary sections aim at developing the musical abilities of the students by providing them with various instruments like tabla, sitar, keyboard, violin, guitar and harmonium. They also get opportunity to create good musical compositions and present them in various functions conducted in the school.







Vocal Music Room

The vocal music rooms at the Pre-primary and Primary sections give training sessions to the students under the guidance of qualified music teachers. The rooms are equipped with key based instruments to tap into the musical pursuits of the students. They are taught the nuances of Indian classical and semi classical music, devotional, folk and patriotic songs.





Visual Arts

The school has separate art and craft room for the Pre-Primary, Primary and Secondary Sections to impart aesthetic sense and creativity in the young minds. This room is a place where they are taught to give rein to their imagination to create their own masterpieces using colours and waste materials.







Cookery Lab

Children should be taught the basic principles of balanced eating and should be encouraged to develop an interest in cooking. In meeting these requirements the school provides a Cooking Room for the Pre-Primary students. Students use basic cooking techniques and develop their culinary skills under the supervision of teachers and attendants.



Clay Centre

The clay centre at the Pre-Primary section provides opportunity for the students to have hands on experience with clay modelling. It gives a perfect platform for the young minds to meet their fantasy needs. The activities help to stimulate their imagination and enhanced hand-eye coordination, colour recognition and motor skills.



Kitchen Garden

Establishing a connection with Nature at an early age is extremely important for the young learners. School garden acts as a powerful education tool in this matter. Students get the opportunity to engage in agricultural practices on a small scale and learn about the responsibilities and impacts of land cultivation. Gardening programmes will instil appreciation and respect for Nature in adulthood.



Motor Skill Centre

The motor skill centre at the Pre- Primary section conducts various structured activities to develop the fine motor skills of the students. The activities are planned in such a way that the students get opportunity to develop various skills, which are actually preparing them for school and for life. They also develop the ability to pay attention, follow instructions and maintain good social behaviour at a young age.







Puppet Theatre

Children often communicate more easily with puppets, giving them confidence to express their ideas and feelings by broadening their own personality. The Puppet Theatre at the Pre- Primary wing provides the opportunity to develop creative skills using handmade puppets thereby prompting them to use their imaginations.





Touch and Learn Centre

Aimed to make learning fun and informative using the modern technology, iPad lab is introduced in Pre-Primary Wing. Students get opportunity to visit the lab in their respective periods to reinforce their normal class room learning. Subject related applications help to make learning meaningful and fun filled.



Aerobics Room

The school gives great emphasis on lifestyle changes, health and fitness of the students. The Aerobics Room in the Pre- Primary helps them to make exercise fun while listening to music.



Chess Room

The school believes that chess is great for a child's brain development. Playing chess significantly improves children's visual memory, attention span, develops logic, critical thinking and problem solving skills, teaches planning and foresight and spatial-reasoning ability too. Students develop these skills under the guidance of a qualified instructor.





Taekwondo Room

The Taekwondo room in the Pre-Primary Section gives opportunity for the students to learn self defence skills at a very young age. Caring, attentive and qualified instructors not only teach them self defence but help them to reap the rewards of fitness, respect for self and others also.



Splash Pool

The splash pool for the Pre-Primary students opens the door for sports opportunities that can be enjoyed in any weather conditions. It allows every student to enjoy aquatic activities under the supervision and expertise of professionals. This aquatic training is a life-long activity and it involves work of most muscle groups in the body, improving flexibility and increasing muscle strength.






Yoga Room

Resource Centre

The Resource Room provides ample reading and reference materials for the students to do projects to reinforce their learning. All subject related reference materials are categorised here for the quick reference for Primary students. Teachers also guide the students for judicious choice of information.



Math Lab

It is a place where one can find a collection of mind games, puzzles and other learning materials. The materials are meant to be used by the students of primary and secondary to understand Mathematical concepts clearly. It helps them to explore the world of Mathematics and develop an interest in the subject. The Math Lab also creates opportunities to apply mathematical principles to solve real world problems through specially designed tasks.





Discovery Lab

At Discovery Lab students of class 3 and 4 learn by doing. Here the students are encouraged to have first-hand experiences with materials rather than learning through lectures or textbooks. This is the place where they think critically, collaborate with peers and share and reflect upon their experiences. It also provides space to conduct group discussion, debates and other activities like model making, chart making, collage work, poster making, etc.





Composite Science Lab

The school has well equipped and well designed General Science Laboratories that cater to the needs of Secondary students. These help them to build a scientific frame of mind and provides opportunities for hands-on activities for the young scientists.





Science and Social Science Lab

The school has well-equipped and well-designed Science and Social Science Lab that caters to the needs of upper primary students. The lab provides opportunity for hands-on activity for the young scientists. It also provides a quick and ready functional environment which not merely provide theoretical but also practical knowledge of Social Sciences to students of class 6. Some of the concepts where imagination is difficult are taught with the help of models and charts. The permanent display of important maps, posters, genealogies and charts and constant reference to them, makes the teaching of Sciences effective, lively and interesting. It also provides space to conduct group discussion, debates and other activities like clay modeling, chart making, collage work, map work, poster making, role play, etc.





Biology Lab

The Biology Lab at the Senior Secondary Section helps the students to gain practical knowledge through various activities. The lab is well equipped with latest instruments, charts, models, etc. Hands-on engagement with the subject material helps the students learn concepts thoroughly.





Chemistry Lab

The Chemistry Lab at the Senior Secondary Section provides a productive learning atmosphere for the students. The lab is well equipped for the young learners to go beyond the prescribed text and gain clarity for various theories and concepts. Students are taught the concepts through demonstrations as well as by doing experiments.





Physics Lab

The Physics Lab at the Senior Secondary is equipped with latest facilities to have hands-on experience for the students. It reinforces the knowledge gained by the students in the theory class by emphasising on the fundamental concepts of Physics. The lab also helps them to develop experimental and analytical skills through direct observation and activities.






